On **June 30th** a number of public sector unions will hold a **one day strike** to oppose the coalition's attempt to mutilate their occupational pension schemes.

The Government want public sector workers to:

- Pay 50% more for their pensions
- Wait five years longer to get them
- Get less when they eventually reach pensionable age

The Government and their allies justify this because public sector workers occupational pensions are better than those in the private sector.

They are absolutely right on this one! It is a scandal that private sector pension schemes are so poor. The solution is to bring private schemes up to the level of the public sector.

If we let them wreck the best pensions in the country then the Government and their business friends will use this as a lever to drive down all other pensions, state as well as private.
